Travis would need to coordinate all the residents at building 7 to not use water at a specific time then observe the water meter to determine if water is flowing indicating a leak.
- b. <u>Profit/Loss.</u> Carrie questioned a charge under pool supplies of \$5,552.85. Travis advised that some of those charges should be under Reserves.
